 - (ii) the enactments administered by the Minister of State administering a Department of State specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order are the enactments specified in the third column of that Schedule opposite to the name of that Department in the first column of that Schedule and any other enactments, whether passed before or after the date of this Order that relate to a matter dealt with by that Department (not being an enactment specified in the third column of the Schedule to the Administrative Arrangements Orders made on 19 December 1972, 5 March 1973, 30 November 1973, in the Administrative Arrangements Orders made on 20 December 1972 and 9 October 1973, in paragraph (b) of the Administrative Arrangements Order made on 4 December 1973, in the third column of the Schedule to this Order opposite to the name of any Department or in sub-paragraphs (vi) and (viii) of this paragraph);
 - (iii) the enactments administered by the Minister of State for Transport no longer include the *Seamen's Compensation Act 1911-1973* and the matters dealt with by the Department of Transport no longer include matters arising under that Act;
 - (iv) the enactments administered by the Treasurer no longer include the *Air Accidents (Australian Government Liability) Act 1963-1973* and the matters administered by the Department of the Treasury do not include matters arising under that Act;
 - (v) the enactments administered by the Minister of State for Housing and Construction no longer include the *Housing Loans Insurance Act 1965-1973* and so much of the *Defence Service Homes Act 1918-1973* as relates to the insurance of dwelling houses under that Act, and the matters administered by the Department of Housing and Construction do not include matters arising under the *Housing Loans Insurance Act 1965-1973* or under so much of the *Defence Service Homes Act 1918-1973* as relates to the insurance of those dwelling houses;

 - (vii) the matters to be administered by the Department of the Special Minister of State include the following matter, namely, Australian Government Purchasing Policy; and
 - (viii) the enactments administered by the Minister of State for Overseas Trade include the *Australian Industry Development Corporation Act 1970-1973* and the matters administered by the Department of Overseas Trade include matters arising under that Act and the following matter, namely, Adjustment Assistance to Industry.
