The enactments administered by the Minister of State administering a Department are the enactments specified in the third column of the Schedule to this Order opposite to the name of that Department and any enactment (whether passed before or after the date on this Order), not being an enactment specified in that column opposite to the name of any Department, that relates to a matter dealt with by that Department.
