AWARDED THE DISTINGUISHED CONDUCT MEDAL

"HIS MAJESTY THE KING has been grac jously pleased to approve of the award of the Distinguished Conduct Medal to the undermentioned soldier, for acts of gallantry and devotion to duty in the Field:

No. 2504A Private C. J. SHANG

For conspic was gallantry and devotion to duty on numerous occasions. He acted as runner continuously for four days through barrages and fire-swept areas, carrying water, food, and ammunition to the front line. He attacked enemy snipers in broad daylight, and accounted for them. In addition to this, he constantly volunteered for dangerous patrols into enemy country, where he gained valuable information as a soout, and also showed remarkable skill in improving lamp signals in a very dangerous position whence he could send information to Battalion Head-quarters. Hescandust showed a never-failing example of fearlessness, resource, and initiative."



Memo from Dr.N.V.Youngman, Brisbane Clinic to B.G.H. Would you please admit C.Shang to Ward 16. He arrived from Cairns yesterday. Apparently 5 weeks ago he was knocked down by a Motor bike and has been "mental" since. An Xray of his skull at Cairns showed no fracture. There was some bruising of the right temporal region.

These are all the details I know and his relatives or other informants are expected down tomorrow.

I hereby give my consent for the transfer of Caleb Shang to the Brisbane Mental Hospital at Goodna. sgd.Anna L.Shang, wife of patient. Transferred; to B.M.H. at 10 a.m.

I have to advise you that the above hamed was admitted to the Brisbane Mental Hospital on the 15th instant and by virtue of "The Mental Hygiene Act of 1938", the Public Curator is the administrator of his estate. I understand that he was in receipt of a Military pension on account of the 1914-1918 War. His address, prior to entering the Mental Hospital, was 348 Sheridan Street, Cairns. At the present time. I have no particulars of his number or battalion and if you can trace the matter; I should be pleased if you would kindly make any pension payable to him, payable to the Public Curator on his behalf. His wife advised me that he had received three medals for distinctive service in the last War.
